Our program may get you off to a good start by offering one "verbal appraisal" item free per person if time/space permits (no guarantee). Items must be small enough to hold in your hand; carry by yourself and hold in your arms, if standing; or place on your lap while sitting during the program. Due to limited room size, please be prepared to stand inside or outside. Front door opens at 6:00 p.m. Helen Bieker's jewelry will be on display and the program will begin with an appraisal of one of her signed pieces. Open to the public. Light refreshments will be available. No house tours at this time (watch for upcoming house tour schedule available during summer concerts). Parking is limited along the brick driveway (please be mindful of new driveway lights along the west side and freshly disturbed soil along the east side). Alternative parking requires a short walk.

No firearms, weapons, Oriental, or Native American items will be appraised.**
