ELIGIBILITY:

Munster students (in both public and private schools) are eligible to join the Munster Junior Historical Society when they are in grades five through eight. Students must complete a Membership Application and pay dues for each year they participate. In grade nine, those students are then eligible to serve us through the MJHS Leadership Program during their high school years. Dues are waived at that level as our older students help and guide our younger ones providing valuable service, leadership, and sound role modeling. After students join us, most continue their affiliation with the MJHS until they graduate from high school.

For the first time in the history of the Munster Jr. Historical Society, we will be allowing fourth graders to join our organization this year under a Legacy Membership if they have an older brother or sister who is or has been an active member of MJHS.
